1. Background

EIT Urban Mobility, supported by the European Institute of Innovation and Technology (EIT), acts to accelerate positive change on mobility to make urban spaces more livable.

EIT Urban Mobility is an initiative of the European Institute of Innovation and Technology (EIT). Since January 2019 we have been working to encourage positive changes in the way people move around cities in order to make them more livable places. We aim to become the largest European initiative transforming urban mobility. Co-funding of up to € 400 million (2020-2026) from the EIT, a body of the European Union, will help make this happen.



We create systemic solutions that will **move more people around the city more efficiently and free up public space.**



We bring **all key players in urban mobility together** to avoid fragmentation and achieve more.



We engage cities and citizens from the word go, giving them the opportunity to become true agents of change.

The EIT Urban Mobility S.L delivers breakthrough innovations to the market and breeds entrepreneurial talent for economic growth and improved quality of life in Europe. It does this by mobilising a pan-European ecosystem of more than 50 top European corporations, SMEs, start-ups, universities, and research institutes constituted into the EIT Urban Mobility Association.

As a Knowledge and Innovation Community (KIC) of the European Institute of Innovation and Technology (EIT), the EIT Urban Mobility S.L is focused on entrepreneurship and is at the forefront of integrating education, research, and business by bringing together students, researchers, engineers, business developers and entrepreneurs. This is done in a pan-European network of Co-Location Centers (CLCs), 5 Limited Liability Companies respectively based in Germany, Czech Republic, Denmark, the Netherlands, and Spain.

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2. General objectives and scope of work

2.1. General Terms & Conditions

The subject of this request for proposal is the selection of the most suitable offer (hereinafter also referred to as "participant" or "tenderer") for the conclusion of a Co-Organiser agreement for the EIT Urban Mobility Annual Summit for years 2025, 2026 and 2027, hereinafter also referred to as "tender". The selection procedure is conducted openly and transparently.

The following documents regulate the terms and conditions under which the selected Tenderer (i.e., Contractor) shall fulfil the specific tasks as a result of the current tender procedure:

- a) The Pre-Qualification Notice;
- b) The Request for Proposal to Co-Organise the EIT Urban Mobility Annual Summit 2025 2027
- c) The Contract to be signed with the selected Tenderer.

The EIT Urban Mobility is responsible for sharing all available, relevant information, existing documents and data on the projects related to which tasks are to be performed by the Contractor based on individual purchase orders, if relevant. The EIT Urban Mobility is responsible for the validity and completeness of all such information.

The working language for the performance of tasks is English.

The Co-Organiser agreement will conclude between the successful tenderer, as contractor, and firm EIT Urban Mobility KIC LE as the Contracting Authority. The company EIT Urban Mobility KIC LE is established under the Spanish law.

2.2. Specific Objectives

From 2021 to 2024, EIT Urban Mobility signed a strategic partnership with FIRA Barcelona, and both organizations launched together the Tomorrow. Mobility World Congress.

During these years, Tomorrow.Mobility has represented EIT Urban Mobility's Annual Summit. The 2024 edition will take place on 5th – 7th November in the city of Barcelona.

To grow its Annual Summit, EIT Urban Mobility is looking to appoint a single provider with whom to coorganise the next 3 editions (congresses) in Barcelona (Spain). EIT Urban Mobility aims to join forces with a well-established tradeshow organisation in Urban Transport and Smart Cities to leverage its success and thus reach more visibility and have a greater impact. The providers are expected to have the level of experience, capacities, and infrastructures to run together a global event on mobility in the city of Barcelona.

The organiser in charge of the upcoming 3 editions of a congress organisation and exploitation should fulfil the following objectives:

- Three (3) event implementation (on a yearly basis from 2025 until 2027) of an Urban Mobility
 Congress for at least 1,000 participants, focused on innovation that brings together the industry,
 government, academia, and research stakeholders, managing both a congress and an exhibition
 area including a demo zone.
- Offering a venue of at least 20.000m2 that can accommodate at least 2 congress rooms with capacity for at least 200 people each and an exhibition area for a minimum of 1,000 people.
- Defining a brand for the Congress that represents the concept of innovation in mobility that is neutral and compatible with both EIT UM brand image and its Event Co-Organiser.
- Event management and administration: promoting/ selling/ billing/ collections/ insurance coverages/ infrastructure/ other required services needed to implement the event (catering, speakers, exhibitors, booth design and build-up, IT services, light & sound, conference steward staff, etc.)
- Organising the logistics and operations of the congress located in Barcelona before, during and
 after the event, including the preparation and improvements implementation for the following
 edition.
- Definition of a marketing strategy in coordination with EIT UM to maximise the number of exhibitors and attendance from key stakeholders of the mobility ecosystem at global level.
- Executing the co-defined marketing and sales plan in coordination with EIT UM, establishing a clear definition of roles and responsibilities
- Rolling out the commercial policy and advertising campaign agreed prior with EIT UM
- · Develop and maintain the official website of the event, including registration page and
- Develop and animate an all-year round online content platform aimed at engaging with delegates and exhibitors to build loyalty for next congress editions.
- Organise a call-for-speakers to generate leads for a series of congress sessions about Urban Mobility and its different sub-topics. A team of evaluators would be defined together with EIT UM, so they could evaluate all speaker proposals and decide which ones are accepted every year to speak at our event.
- Creation of an attendee data base including its maintenance in co-ownership with EIT UM and compliance with privacy and applicable EU regulations on data sharing and management.

- Offer a revenue-share scheme to EIT Urban Mobility based on the income generated by the congress event
- Provide an exhibition area, demo zone and pitch area at dedicated reduced prices for start-ups of EIT Urban Mobility's portfolio
- Provide services to EIT Urban Mobility activities during the Congress, including but not limited to steward service, catering, simultaneous translation, etc.
- Offer unique conditions and discounts to EIT Urban Mobility and its partners to participate in the congress as exhibitors and/or delegates.
- Put in practice a sustainability action plan to reduce and offset greenhouse gas emissions with the aim to become a carbon neutral congress in the mid-long term.

2.3. Timing and planning

2.3.1 Start date & period of implementation

The intended start date is, at the latest, 3rd February 2025 until 31st December 2027.

3. Pre-Qualification procedure

The pre-qualification is the first phase of the two-stage procedure of selecting winning Tenderer to implement the organisation and exploitation of the EIT Urban Mobility Annual Summit.

During the pre-qualification procedure, EIT Urban Mobility will, based upon the presented technical/professional capacity, establish a list of potential Tenderers. During the second phase the EIT Urban Mobility will invite pre-qualified Tenderers to submit a detailed bid.

Please note that alliance of pre-qualified applicants to submit joint tender will be only allowed in the second phase, when both applicants have been selected in the pre-qualification stage.

3.1. Participation

Participation is open to all interested firms. Applicants may not form alliance to jointly submit applications.

All applicants must sign a Letter of Interest in the form provided by the EIT Urban Mobility, attached as Annex 1 to the present Notice.

3.3. Submission of the application

The EIT Urban Mobility notes that Applications will be deemed timely received or submitted by the EIT Urban Mobility if they are received by the EIT Urban Mobility by the submission deadline. All risks associated with delays will be borne by the Applicants only.

All times specified in hours in any procedural document are to be understood as **Spanish local** time.

The EIT Urban Mobility will consider Applications submitted after the submission deadline as invalid.

The representative of the EIT Urban Mobility will make records of the opening of the Applications, which will be sent to all Applicants within 3 days from the opening of Applications.

The application shall contain:

- A signed Letter of Interest (Annex 1), including the list of relevant experience.
- Reference Letter(s) proving the experience(s) presented to comply with pre-qualification selection criteria described in Section 4.1. The Reference Letter(s) must include all necessary information that will allow the EIT Urban Mobility to fully assess compliance with the pre-qualification selection criteria. Please note that experience listed but not, or only partially supported by Reference Letter, will not be considered.

The Applicant must submit its application via email in proper (legibly) scanned and non-editable PDF, which is accessible without entering a password. Application may not be submitted by joint Applicants.

3.4. Request for clarifications

The Applicant may seek to receive additional information about the provisions of the documentation before the submission deadline from the EIT Urban Mobility, who will provide the requested information at least one day before the submission deadline.

EIT Urban Mobility is not obliged to answer questions in case it makes a decision not to do so.

With a view to ensuring a rapid response to the questions received, the EIT Urban Mobility asks the Applicants to send their questions in an editable MS Word format.

4. Evaluation of applications

4.1 Pre-qualification selection criteria

The pre-qualification will be based on the professional capacity of the Applicant. The following selection criteria will apply:

Number of Congresses organised around the topic of mobility in 2021 - 2024	
As evidence the tenderer must provide examples (pictures and descriptions) and results (number of attendees) for events organised around the topic of mobility.	
Based on this evidence the tenderer will be scored as follows:	Max. 30 points.
6 or more events organised will receive 30 points 5 events organised will receive 25 points 4 events organised will receive 20 points 3 events organised will receive 15 2 events organised will receive 10 points	
1 event organised will receive 5 points	
Total number of attendees in Congresses organised around the topic of mobility in 2021 - 2024	
As evidence the tenderer must provide specific figures regarding the amount of participants at events organised around the topic of mobility.	
Based on this evidence the tenderer will be scored as follows:	Max. 20 points.
Total amount of guests exceeds 7.000 attendees: 20 points	
Total amount of guests exceeds 5.000 attendees: 15 points	
Total amount of guests exceeds 3.000 attendees: 10 points	
Total amount of guests exceeds 1.000 attendees: 5 points	

Total max score: .50 points

Applicants are allowed to refer to contracts completed within the reference period even if started earlier.

Reference Letters must contain all relevant data allowing the EIT Urban Mobility to fully assess the compliance of the Applicant, otherwise the experience will not be considered.

4.2 Selection of the applicants

The invited applicants will be informed in writing (via email) about the result of the pre-selection procedure.

4.3 Cancellation of the proposal procedure

In the event of cancellation of the pre-qualification procedure, the EIT Urban Mobility will notify Applicants on the cancellation. In no event shall EIT Urban Mobility be liable for any damages in any way connected with the cancellation of the procedure.

4.4 Appeals / Complains

Applicants believing that they have been harmed by an error or irregularity during the evaluation process of the applications may file a complaint. Appeals should be addressed to the EIT Urban Mobility. The Applicants have 3 days to file their complaints from the receipt of the letter of the notification of selection.

4.5 Ethics clauses / Corruptive practices

EIT Urban Mobility reserves the right to suspend or cancel the procedure, where the selection procedure proves to have been subject to substantial errors, irregularities, or fraud. If substantial errors, irregularities, or fraud are discovered after the award of the Contract, the EIT Urban Mobility may refrain from concluding the Contract.

The Applicant shall take all measures to prevent any situation where the impartial and objective implementation of the contract is compromised for reasons involving economic interest, political or national affinity, family or emotional ties or any other shared interest ('conflict of interests'). He should inform the EIT Urban Mobility immediately if there is any change in the above circumstances at any stage during the implementation of the tasks.
